JOHN BINKLEY'S GASLINE PLAN

JOHN BINKLEY WILL:

- Only support a deal that actually gets a gas pipeline built.
- Negotiate from a position of strength – we must use our leverage, including putting all options back on the table if necessary.
- Ensure the development of Pt. Thomson – a critical component of the gasline.
- Make sure Alaskans have jobs and access to gas to lower their cost of energy.
- Push for a fair and simple oil tax plan that will:
 - Be based on the price of oil, not oil companies' profits.
 - Increase oil flowing down the pipeline by focusing on credits for exploration, drilling wells and incentives to keep smaller, independent companies in business.
 - Include a progressive feature so that when oil prices are high, local tax payers will benefit.
- Not use high oil prices as an excuse to build a bigger government – we need a fiscal plan to save for the future.
